

### A wide range of customers

At SKANOL we offer services within several different segments:

#### **Fuel for service stations**

Using optimum transport equipment and well-trained drivers we transport both partial and full loads to petrol and diesel stations throughout the Nordic countries.

The key words for our logistics solutions are quality, flexibility and punctuality, while also placing a strong focus on transport economy and efficiency.

SKANOL has extensive knowledge of various remote measuring and ullage systems, including technical standards required etc.

### Lubricating oil for industry, shipping and workshops

Every day, SKANOL's drivers deliver many different types of lubricating oils to industrial customers in very different segments, such as vehicle repair shops, industrial companies and ships.

This is where it is essential for our drivers to know the products, each individual customers' facilities, tank installation and requirements. Our drivers are consequently specially trained to handle these special assignments independently and with a high level of quality.

### **Bunkering of ships**

Ships call into port 24 hours a day, which requires a great deal of flexibility and a high level of delivery reliability in connection with bunkering. SKANOL provides nationwide capacity in the form of equipment, fittings and the employees needed to complete deliveries, sometimes under difficult conditions – without compromising on quality, safety or the environment.

Our employees are also specially trained to handle the comprehensive documentation requirements in connection with e.g. bunkering of foreign-going vessels.



### Aviation fuel for airports and airfields

SKANOL supplies Scandinavian airports with jet fuel from refineries and tank stores 24 hours a day. This is done using custom-built and weight-optimised tankers adapted to local conditions.

### Oil distribution to agricultural, industrial, business and private customers

SKANOL's drivers make hundreds of oil deliveries to private customers, agricultural enterprises and businesses all over the Nordic countries on behalf of our own customers every day, all year round. This requires strong planning, flexibility and understanding of each customers' needs.

The assignments have to be prioritised correctly, and capacity must be available for urgent orders and any other sudden needs that may arise. The customers' tanks must never be empty. SKANOL has many years of experience in planning this type of distribution, which involves high complexity and the possibility of large seasonal fluctuations as well as the need for rapid capacity adjustments

Our drivers also understand the need to take the conditions of each and every customer site into account in order to achieve our goal: to fill the tank without the customer noticing that we have paid them a visit. This requires our drivers to have an intimate knowledge of not only tank installations and equipment but also products and preventive environmental and safety measures.

Efficient IT integration allows us to ensure a 100% paperless order flow from the customer to delivery and reporting of delivery data from the vehicle as soon as delivery is complete. Our systems can handle and document advanced processes such as additives and flushing.

### Transport of chemicals and technical products to industry

Handling and transportation of hazardous goods require in-depth knowledge and care. SKANOL's drivers are selected and trained to work with hazardous goods, and SKANOL's corporate culture is characterised by a high focus on preventive safety.

The organisation has extensive knowledge of both relevant legislation and the structure and safe use of fit-for-purpose transport equipment for each assignment.

### Controlling tank supply - Vendor Managed Inventory

Working with SKANOL ensures that your tank is always full. We monitor stock levels, allowing our customers to spend less time on administration, thus freeing up resources. We employ the latest technology within Vendor Managed Inventory – which ensures that we can always monitor stock levels in the customers' tank.

SKANOL can also handle all types of order flows at fixed or variable intervals, such as date ranges, hourly settings, etc.

### **Efficient information technology**

SKANOL has the best IT solutions in the market for handling logistics within road tanker transportation of hazardous goods.

We offer efficient and customised interfaces. This means a 100% paperless flow from the customer's ERP system to the advanced metering systems in our road tankers, which report accurate delivery data to the customer in real-time. This applies regardless of whether this relates to smaller bulk deliveries or full loads. The systems ensure accurate and efficient management of data and the option to automatically reconcile volumes.

## Multi-share distribution – focus on efficiency, flexibility and the environment

Our multi-share distribution solutions means that we can load and deliver products for multiple customers on the same vehicle. This makes sense as it allows optimal use of the equipment.

The high number of kilometres this saves is good for the environment and increases flexibility though more regular deliveries to remote and sparsely populated areas – while the increase in efficiency keeps costs down.

### Focus on safety, quality, the environment and working environment

SKANOL is certified according to several internationally recognised standards:

In our work handling hazardous goods, we are also very aware that we bear a very special responsibility, both in relation to our employees and the surrounding community whenever our tankers are out on the roads. Quality, the environment and working environment are not just a question of certifications to us.

We work systematically with these issues through e.g.:

- > 100% monitoring of compliance with rules on driving and rest periods
- > Systematic, web-based reporting of all damage/injuries and near misses
- > Mandatory physical check-ups for all employees
- > The use of modern technology in the form of eco-driving, alcolocks, distance radar, etc.
- > Speed restrictors set to 80 km/h
- > Regular safety walks
- > GPS tracking and electronic monitoring of driving style (eco-driving)
- > Comprehensive fleet management programme for equipment maintenance and inspections
- > Systematic continuous training of drivers
- > The most weight-optimised road tankers in the market allow an increased payload, reducing the environmental impact via fewer kilometres driven
